The cabinet under the bathroom sink in the 2's Room contained hand sanitizer labeled "keep out of reach of children". The cabinet under the kitchenette sink in the Preschool Room contained a sanitizer spray and a bottle of floor cleaner, labeled "keep out of reach of children". The cabinet under the sink in the downstairs Activity Room contained Comet cleaning spray and a Windex bottle, labeled "keep out of reach of children".</p>	<p>Child locks will be placed in kitchen cabinets and bathrooms. Thermometers were placed in the refrigerator and freezer immediately during visit. A daily check will be done each morning to ensure thermometers are in place.	12/2/2025	
4	251.07(4)(c) <b>Naps Or Rest Periods - Sleeping Surfaces - Children Under 1</b>  Description: It was observed during the monitoring visit that pack n' plays in the Infant Nap Room were placed end-to-end with no solid partition separating them. Other pack n' plays were also placed less than 2 feet apart in an "L" shape. Rule states that cribs or playpens may be placed end-to-end if a solid partition separates the crib or playpen and an aisle not less than 2 feet in width is maintained between sleeping surfaces to maintain proper supervision and safety measures.	Pack n' plays were arranged in suggested plan by the licenser which allows the end to end placement with 2 feet space between aisles. Solid partitions are in place between all pack-n-plays. This room arrangement will be used immediately.	12/2/2025
