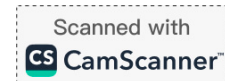

1	<p>251.07(2)(e) Child Guidance - Prohibited Actions</p> <p>Description: In the Stork Classroom on 2/11/26, a staff member used potentially injurious prohibited actions when they picked a child up by their onesie and flipped them around from their belly to their back. This incident was self-reported by the program.</p> <p>In the Tiger Classroom on 2/20/26, staff dragged a child across the floor with a hula hoop and another staff grabbed the same child by the wrists and restrained the child. This was self-reported by the program.</p>	<p>This was found during a routine camera audit. No other team member witnessed this. Employee was immediately put on leave, DCF notified + parent notified. We talk each month about prohibited actions and our zero tolerance for abuse + neglect @ KSLC</p>	6/4/26	

→ This was witnessed by a Leadership member, both team members put on leave while Administrator reviewed. Upon review, one employee was terminated and one left the program. DCF was notified as well as child's parent.

We have an anonymous tip line where teachers + parents can report any concern + camera footage is promptly reviewed

This incident was self-reported by the program.</p> <p>Repeat violation: Previously cited on 7/12/2024</p>	<p>This was also observed on routine camera footage. All infant teachers have had a full re-train of our best practices to include KSLC's belief in not participating in the cry it out method. Parent was notified.</p>	6/4/26	
3	<p>251.07(2)(e)5. Prohibited Actions - Cruel, Aversive, Frightening, Humiliating Actions</p> <p>Description: In the Stork Classroom, a staff member used cruel and frightening actions when they were clapping in a child's face to stop them from crying and told a child "you're not dying, you're fine". These actions were self-reported by the program.</p> <p>Repeat violation: Previously cited on 7/8/2025, 7/12/2024</p>	<p>Same team member. They no longer work here + were let go due to the observed abuse on camera. All footage was reviewed and all these incidents got promptly reported and parent was notified.</p>	6/4/26	
4	<p>251.09(2)(a) Infant & Toddler - Responding To Crying Children</p> <p>Description: In the Stork Classroom on 2/11/26, staff did not respond promptly to a crying child's need when a child was crying alone in their crib for an extended period. This incident was self-reported by the program.</p>	See above	6/4/26
