1	251.055(1)(a) Supervision Of Children Description: The director self reported on February 13, 2026, child care worker(s) failed to supervise a three-and-a-half-year-old child when the child was left outside for approximately one minute in the fenced in play space. A high school teacher/students on the adjacent side walk found the child and returned the child to the front door of the center.	On February 13, 2026, we promptly reported an incident where a child stayed on the playground and then contacted their parents. Teachers lined up the children, performed a headcount, and moved them to the nearby playground before transitioning to the classroom. Video footage shows that the child hid inside a play structure while teachers led the group to the adjacent playground and into the building. A local high school group was nearby, and their teacher quickly brought the child back into our attendance. Our corrective action plan includes maintaining thorough headcounts, utilizing name-to-face recognition with the Brightwheel app, conducting comprehensive sweeps of the playground, and ensuring one teacher remains at the back of the line as children exit each area.	4/29/2026	



2	<p>251.055(1)(f) Child Tracking Procedure</p> <p>Description: On February 13, 2026, child care worker(s) failed to accurately implement the program's child tracking procedure. A child failed to be signed into the bright wheel app indicating the accurate number of children present. When the workers completed a head count the number of children indicated on the app did not accurately reflect the number of children present. This resulted in a three-and-a-half-year-old child being left outside for approximately two minutes. The workers were not aware of the child's whereabouts until the child was returned to the classroom.</p>	<p>On February 13, 2026, we promptly reported an incident where a child stayed on the playground and then contacted their parents. Teachers lined up the children, performed a headcount, and moved them to the nearby playground before transitioning to the classroom. Video footage shows that the child hid inside a play structure while teachers led the group to the adjacent playground and into the building. A local high school group was nearby, and their teacher quickly brought the child back into our attendance.</p> <p>In alignment with our corrective action plan for supervision practices, we have instituted rigorous headcounts using name-to-face recognition via the Brightwheel app, conduct thorough playground and classroom sweeps, and ensure that a designated teacher remains at the rear of the line as children transition between areas. Additionally, each child is cross-checked upon entering new spaces or classrooms to maintain accurate attendance and safety.</p>	4/29/2026
